↳ Fund Raisers for the Leader's Council was revisited:

- The Saddle Warmers and the Leaders' Council will be working in the Rodeo Burger Booth. The Rodeo Assn. will pay each group \$225 to run the booth on Friday and Saturday from 8pm-10pm.
