

## **Lincoln County 4-H Horse Leaders' Meeting**

June 2, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

### **MINUTES:**

Jerry made a motion to approve May 5<sup>th</sup> minutes as read. Lydia seconded. Motion passed.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT:**

Denise reported that the Horse Leaders' account has \$554.34. The Horse Camp account has \$1,569.80. The CD is worth \$3,225.05. Lydia stated that the ribbons came to \$36.99. Denise will leave a check for \$10.00 for the rental of the room for tonight's meeting. Lydia stated that the arena rent needs paid for the Clinic and Summer Sizzler. Lydia also stated she will fill out insurance forms for both. Diane made a motion to approve these payments. Brenda seconded. Motion carried.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Clinic – Jeanie stated that we are 2 people short to break even. Eight are from Lincoln County. There are 2 from Grant County coming, and the people from Addy that came last year are all coming again. Denise suggested we put an ad in the Exchange. She made a motion, and Robin seconded. The money for the ad will be paid from the Horse Camp account. Also, Dusti is waiving all late fees for people that register late.

Summer Sizzler – Robin sent 15 emails to prospective judges. She didn't get many replies. She told us about an apprentice judge from Prosser (Kathryn Holden) who charges \$13.00 per hour plus the cost of fuel (approx. \$40). She gave Robin references. A motion was made to hire this judge for the clinic. The motion was seconded and carried. Dusti has a judges' contract on her computer. None of the judges that Ann Garrett recommended returned Robin's emails. Most of the judges are booked or unavailable. Robin is also asking judges if they would be interested in judging at fair in August. One judge in Deer Park expressed interest. Another, from Republic, would cost us at least \$513. Jeanie stated that we now may have 2 qualifiers for state (games). Tamara wanted to know if she could look at their Record Books the day before, but the rules state the qualifiers have to bring their Record Book to Summer Sizzler that morning. Bridget volunteered to look at Record Books if Tamara wasn't available. Darla offered to do a jumping class if we get enough kids to sign up for that class. It was noted that the judge needs to see a warm-up jump before they can compete in jumping. Darla also offered to set up the trail pattern for that class. Robin said there was no pattern in the equitation class. Lydia mentioned that the arena is rented and will be ready.

**FAIR:**

Lydia wanted to know if we know of anyone who would want to be in charge of the judging class at fair. To be put in the premium book, this needs to be decided within one week. Darla offered to do this if she could get 4 classes put together. She will need help, also. Tamara reminded everyone that Record Books are due August 6<sup>th</sup>.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Deciding about the items underneath the stage was tabled until another meeting.

Annie G. received the Horse Leaders' scholarship. She gets the money in January.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Robin talked about the Lincoln County Livestock Club's clinic on judging and fitting and showing. This will be for all animals. Robin said she needs 2 more teens to help her demonstrate. Darla said she would ask Kaleah, and Brenda will ask Annie. The clinic takes place on June 17<sup>th</sup>.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

Bridget announced that Janet Kiser Lambarth will present her research on "Women and Their Horses," on July 10<sup>th</sup> at the Ephrata courthouse in the multi-purpose room.

We may have a meeting on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Robin will let us know. If not, the next meeting will be August 4<sup>th</sup>.

Tamara made a motion to adjourn meeting. Jerry seconded.
