

## **Lincoln County 4-H Horse Leader's Meeting**

Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM.

Robin was the facilitator at tonight's meeting. Introductions were made around the table.

### **MINUTES**

Justine made a motion to approve the minutes from June's meeting. Denise seconded. Motion passed.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

Denise reported that the Horse Camp account and the Horse Leaders' account have been combined. It will be known as the Horse Leaders' account. She mentioned that the CD certificate matures on 8/9/09. It will be rolled over. Denise stated that she paid Jeanie for the lunches at Horse Clinic and rent to the fairgrounds for our monthly meetings. She did not pay for the rent of the fairgrounds arena for Horse Clinic (see committee report).

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Clinic** - Robin stated that the clinic went well. We pretty much broke even. The figures are not completely in. The reason for not paying the rent is because of the situation with the arena at the start of the clinic. The arena was to be ready by 8. It wasn't ready until 9, so the clinic couldn't start on time. Robin stated that Dusti had written a letter to the fair board asking that the rent be reduced. It was brought up that it would be a good idea, in addition to the letter, if someone can go to the fair board meeting this coming Friday to discuss with them what happened.

**Summer Sizzler** - Robin stated that she has a signed contract with a judge. She said the judge has been hard to get a hold of. There are 3 kids trying out for state. There is a total of 13 signed up for Summer Sizzler. A discussion was held as to whether the show should be cancelled. It was suggested that fair could be the qualifying show. Having 2-3 kids per class is not really feasible. Denise was concerned that if we cancelled Summer Sizzler, it would go away for this year and never come back. Some suggestions made were to combine our qualifying show with another county's show - have a Bi-County or Tri-County qualifying show. Bridget stated that other counties were having the same problems with low numbers as well. Another suggestion was that if someone from Lincoln County wanted to try for state, they could always attend another county's qualifying show. Jerry made a motion to keep Summer Sizzler. Lydia seconded. Motion passed. Robin said she needs volunteers to help. Denise will take care of the insurance. It was also discussed that maybe we could shorten the day - change the time of games. The games could be pushed up earlier. It was also noted that with the small number of kids

participating they will need time in between classes so they aren't rushed.

**Fair** - Lydia mentioned that the fair needs a demonstration superintendent. She also passed around copies of the premium book pages for Dept. 10, Horses and Mules.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Denise agreed to be the coordinator for state.

Isha R. from the Reardan Renegades was here to ask permission to use a different horse for fair. She explained that her 25 yr. old horse, Romeo Star, did not winter well. He still has not gained enough weight. She asked the leaders for permission to use her dad's trail horse. She understands that she will get no premium money, she can't qualify for state and she couldn't participate in Round Robin. Tamara made a motion to allow Isha to use her dad's mare for fair. Lydia seconded. Motion passed. Isha will get Lydia a new horse ID form and picture.

Justine announced that the NBHA is having a barrel race on Sunday. She wants to rent the electric eye from the Horse Leaders. Jerry made a motion to let Justine rent the eye for \$25.00. Diane seconded. Motion passed.

A possible meeting will be held on Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, depending on how Summer Sizzler goes.

Diane made a motion to adjourn meeting. Justine seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:25 PM.
