



# “Important Things to Know” for Lincoln County Fair 4-H Exhibitors



In an attempt to make our youths' fair experience more enjoyable, the following review list has been created and distributed by Lincoln County 4-H Leaders Council to help guide you and your youth through their fair experience.

If you were an exhibitor last year you should receive a Premium (rule) Book in the mail in July. If a new exhibitor or you didn't receive one, they will be available to pickup at the Fair Office or local post offices. Lincoln Co Fair address is PO Box 490, Davenport, WA 99122 or call 509-725-5161.

## **July 16 – August 6, 2008**



Secure Premium Book - read General Fair Rules  
and all rules pertaining to your exhibits

Pre-Tag Market Beef, Sheep, Swine, and Goats in the right ear prior to Fair.  
Sheep and Goats must also have a scrapie ear tag prior to weigh-in.

Pick up entry forms, exhibit tags, exhibitor liability waivers & exhibitor number at  
the fair office (only get 1 exhibitor number for all open, 4-H, & FFA entries)

Check with your leader - your club may have entry, stall card, season pass  
or other standards they implement

Reserve & pay for camper parking if camping on-site (after books are out)

Pay for season pass and camper fees as needed

## **Due by August 6<sup>th</sup> - No later than 5 pm in fair office** (leave time for lines)

**Liability waivers**, season passes, and camper fees

**All animal entries and entry fees**, (*Animal Exhibits include beef, cats, goats, horses, poultry, rabbits, sheep, & swine*) You must have a season pass to exhibit your animal.

**Record books** with completed entry form and exhibitor tag

**Educational Posters** with completed entry form and exhibitor tag

**Entries Forms for:**

- **Livestock and/or Horse Judging Contests**
- **Exhibit Booths & Displays**
- **4-H in Action** (Foods and or Clothing Activities)
- **Demonstrations**

## Wednesday - day before fair

Gates open to receive all livestock at 3:30 pm  
(check Premium Book for weigh-in schedule)

Horses must be in place by 8 pm

All other animal exhibits in place by 10 pm

Except Cats - check in Thursday by 9 am

They may go home each night at 8 pm or be caged overnight

All non-animal exhibits without early deadlines **MUST BE RECEIVED** 3:30– 9pm.  
(Baking & Floral have special times –check your premium book)

Quality Assurance Forms must be completed, signed & submitted at weigh-in  
for market beef, sheep, swine, & goats

Beef must turn in brand slip and certificate of permit also at time of weigh-in

All black-faced sheep capable of breeding must have scrapies tag or tattoo

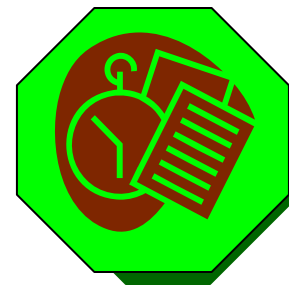
Rabbits must be tattooed. If not, check with superintendent for arrangements

Bring your own feed, feed pans, water bucket, & cleaning supplies for your  
animal and its stall (e.g. wheelbarrow, shovels, etc)

Collect educational posters previously entered from the  
main building to display in your barn

Decorate animal exhibit area and put up stall cards. “Crafty” stall/pen  
decoration items may also be entered as a “Craft Exhibit.” Note location of craft  
on Exhibit form.

Sign up with barn superintendents for herdsmanship duties



## Sunday - last day of fair

Fair closes at 3 pm

**All exhibits and decorations must remain in place until this time.**

Exhibits must be picked up before 4:30pm

After this time exhibits will be moved to the main building  
to be picked up Monday at 9am – 3:00 pm
